



## INTRODUCTION TO THE COLLECTION

The excellence of a collection depends upon the knowledge, taste and dedication of the collector. A cellar of fine and rare wines is no exception. Knowledge of what to buy and when to buy it must be matched by dedication in ensuring that the collection is balanced and fits the use for which it is intended. This need for balance is perhaps the most overlooked feature in evaluating wine cellars today. To be balanced, a collection should not only include representatives from the great wines of the world, but should extend to vintages and varieties which will ensure that most tastes and most occasions, ranging from formal meals to informal gatherings, can be adequately and elegantly catered by appropriate selections.

A collection of this scope is rare indeed, and creating such a cellar becomes increasingly difficult with each passing year. However, beyond the many years necessary to assemble such a cellar, the maintenance of the collection calls for conditions of storage which are difficult to meet. The physical facilities, temperature controls, humidity, absence of vibration, darkness, and above all, the constant monitoring of the development of wines in the collection, call for a rare level of concern and expertise.

The Benjamin Ichinose collection of wines was assembled to provide its owner with personal and social pleasure. Wine is fragile and perishable. Ultimately, the value of rarity depends for the most part on the owner's ability to maintain optimum conditions for comfortable survival over the longest period of time. Few collections have been as carefully and consistently pampered as this one. In the process, wines reaching their peak have been identified and have appropriately provided unique moments of pleasure for host and guests. More importantly, the collection has been strengthened since the removal of wines was never at the capricious demand of an unrelenting public (as in so many restaurant collections), but was patiently governed by serious interest in increasing both the knowledge and the pleasure of those who shared in the experience.

The physical conditions in the cellar are close to perfect. There are three separate storage rooms for optimal aging of the various types of wines. The 49° cellar contains old red wines and all white wines. This temperature tends to hold mature wines and prevent decay, while it allows the white wines to slowly reach a peak of perfection which they would not achieve if they were aged warmer, and therefore faster. The 54° cellar contains younger red wines up to 30 years old. The 58° cellar is for younger fortified wines, sherrys, ports and madeiras. Fortified wines up to 50 years old must be stored at a higher temperature than other reds to ensure proper maturation.

The cellar is humidified to 70% and is earthquake protected. Set below ground, it is subject to minimum vibrations, and has been professionally managed by an experienced cellar master. He has ensured that conditions of storage are maintained and monitored the progress of the wine as it reaches maturity.

On the following pages wines are grouped by country of origin and listed by year, in appropriate sections. Significant statistics on the collection are provided in the final chapters of the book, and selected comments from those who have had an opportunity to view the collection recently are also included.

## B. THE QUALITY OF THE COLLECTION

### [i] THE GREAT YEARS

- 5 star — outstanding; highest class of vintage
- 4 star — excellent vintage
- 3 star — good vintage

Where an asterisk or star appears in brackets, i.e. **\*\*\*(\*)**, this indicates that the overall rating is **\*\*\*** but some wines can be exceptionally good and rate **\*\*\*\***

#### **\*\*\*\* 1865**

Excellent vintage, still full coloured. Magnificent, deep and firm with prolific quantity. The wines took a long time to come around. The Chateau Lafite was an exceptional wine in this year. The bottles in the cellar were sold by George Claridge, who at that time was the most famous wine merchant in England. It is Chateau bottled with embossed capsules and branded corks. The wine is drinking excellently, with a deep, brick-red colour and a good vinous quality.

#### **\*\*\*\*\* 1870**

Great, full, magnificent vintage. Professor George Saintsbury described the 1870 clarets as "dumb" when they were forty years old. Drunk recently, the Chateau Lafite Rothschild was fruity, powerful, very flavorful, and long on the palate. Both Chateau Lafite Rothschild and Chateau Mouton Rothschild were exceptional in this vintage and are represented in the cellar. The wines came from Glamis Castle, the seat of the Earl of Strathmore and Kinghorne, a cousin of the Queen. Michael Broadbent described the physical conditions of this cellar as "ideal". Harry Waugh said that the magnum of 1870 Lafite from Glamis Castle that he tasted was the greatest pre-phylloxera claret that he had ever tasted.

#### **\*\*\*\* 1874**

"Good but variable now. A huge vintage, but the wines were a little weak. They have not lasted as well as many vintages, but the magnum of 1874 Chateau Lafite Rothschild in this cellar is probably the best 1874 existing. It is from the cellar of the Viscount Boyne at Brancepeth Castle, Durham, England."

**\*\*\*\*\* 1875**

Great but light and variable. Lafite is at its best and perfect. The wines of this vintage could probably be compared to 1929 or 1947 in that they were delicious early on. However, the best wines have lasted and even improved. The Chateau Lafite Rothschild in the cellar was also sold by George Claridge and is Chateau bottled. It is a beautiful, delicate wine, with a sweet finish, although not a huge wine.

**\*\*\*\* 1878**

Good and fairly dependable. The last pre-phyloxera vintage, with a fairly large quantity. Not a vintage for huge wines, being between the 1870 and 1874 in terms of body. The wines of this vintage probably should be drunk fairly soon to be seen at their present best.

**\*\*\* 1893**

The first great post-phyloxera vintage. An exceptionally hot summer, followed by an early vintage, produced excellent wines. Certainly the most famous is the 1893 Chateau Latour. It is an excellent wine with tannin and real Pauillac character.

**\*\*\*\* 1900**

Marvelous year, big and reliable.

**\*\*\* 1920**

Great year, big wines, fruity and refined. The 1920-1929 period was one of the most successful decades enjoyed by Bordeaux. Some are spotty and thinning but it is astonishing how good many are. The 1920 Chateau Latour and Chateau Haut Brion are fine wines. The 1920 Chateau Latour is regarded by many to be the finest Latour of this century, although the 1929 Chateau Latour probably has more partisans who would award it the palm.

**\*\* 1921**

A very hot summer. This vintage has been compared to 1947. The 1921 Chateau Mouton Rothschild is one of the most rare wines in the cellar; old Moutons have always been much harder to obtain than the wines of Lafite.

**\*\*\* 1924**

Good, firm, fine vintage.

\*\*\*\* 1928

Great, unyielding tough wines. Only just coming within their own now. Elegant. A very big year, with very hard tannic wines initially. The Chateau Latour is so huge that one wonders when it will ever soften completely. This is a wine for people who are fond of strong, heavy claret. Chateau Palmer drunk a couple of weeks ago is at its peak!

\*\*\*\*\* 1929

Exquisite year. In some ways, "the vintage of the century". The vintage was fairly plentiful and the wines are very nearly perfect claret. They have good color, with a sweet, rich, grapey flavour and exceptionally fine, delicate aroma. Some are fading.

\*\*\*\*\* 1945

"Great year. In my opinion, the greatest since 1870. They are outstanding and will last for decades," says Mr. Michael Broadbent. A very short vintage, like 1961. The small quantity was caused by a disastrous spring frost. Some writers feel that this is the "vintage of the century". Certainly the best and most famous is the chateau Mouton Rothschild, which is well represented in the cellar.

\*\*(\*) 1947

A very hot summer caused the wines of this vintage to be very rich and slightly uneven. The wines are at their peak now. The Chateau Cheval Blanc is an extraordinary wine; Chateau Cheval Blanc at its best, although the Chateau Mouton Rothschild and Chateau Petrus must not be slighted.

\*\* 1948

Hard and masculine. Good in their way. An underrated vintage, falling as it does between 1947 and 1949. The wines are beautifully balanced and perfect now.

\*\*\*(\*) 1949

Much better than its current reputation, holding better than the 1947's. A vintage that made big wines, they will improve for some years to come.

\*\*(\*) 1952

Hard and dull in the Medoc but sound. Excellent in St. Emillion and Pomerol. Only now starting to drink well.

**\*\*\*\* 1953**

Well nigh perfect claret. Elegant. A softer year, the wines are at their peak. Chateau Lafite Rothschild, and Chateau Petrus are excellent.

**\*\* 1955**

Much better than rated. Beginning to show class.

**\*\* 1959**

Stoggy, heavyweight wines. Highly touted at the outset, the wines seem softer now. The wines will be at their peak within twelve years. Very interesting vintage to watch.

**\*\*\*\*\* 1961**

A very fine year indeed. Best vintage this century after 1945. The wines will improve for ten to thirty years. Chateau Petrus and Chateau Mouton Rothschild are probably the best.

**\*\* 1962**

Good, reliable, well balanced. Excellent drinking and will continue for many years.

**\*\*\* 1966**

Elegant and typical claret at its easiest best. Well balanced. Like 1953's in a way. Very good vintage. Will improve for some time.

**1970**

Very good and showing great promise. Too early to assess accurately.



### C. THE CONSISTENT STRENGTH OF CALIFORNIA

In writing of the wine of California, Robert Louis Stevenson commented on "the inimitable fragrance and soft fire" and likened the wine to "bottled poetry." While this literary evaluation may not impress a connoisseur, the more scientific observations of Hugh Johnson, a noted English wine writer, attest to California's pre-eminence among wine countries of the New World. He attributes this partly to climatic and partly to social conditions. He further states, "Today, Northern California is one of the world's great cultural centers. The concentration of intelligent demand, interest and discussion is a constant challenge to wine makers to improve their wine. The best of California wines today are among the world's best."

The winemaking skills of California vintners are second to none. Students from France and Germany are enrolled at the University of California's Davis campus in order to study under famous professors of viticulture and enology. The wines have strong varietal character and bouquet and are more fruity than their French counterparts. They are also less harsh and are drinkable earlier. Unfortunately, the floor tax in California discourages the aging of wine, and vintages beyond five years are rare and expensive.

However, when allowed to do so, California red and white wines age well. The Cabernet Sauvignons develop a bouquet and character reminiscent of the great Burgundies — rich in taste and aroma. Personal contact with proprietors of the best California vinyards has ensured that this collection includes a full range of outstanding vintages and a unique introduction to the finest wine this state has to offer.
